Electoral Act 1907, section 175LQ

This form is to lodge the annual return for the State campaign account with the Western Australian Electoral Commission. It must be completed by the responsible person for a political entity. Please complete all parts of the form, indicating payments made into and out of the State campaign account.

Timeframe for notification

The political entity must lodge the State campaign account annual return with the Commission by 30 November each year for the previous financial year. This return will be made available for public inspection at the end of four weeks following that date.
