



# Notice of registered officer

*Electoral Act 1907, section 4*

The registered officer of a political party is the secretary of the party. If the political party would like to have a second registered officer, this form should be used to notify the Western Australian Electoral Commission (the Commission) of that person's details, or changes to that person's details.

The registered officer can appoint scrutineers, and perform the duties of the party secretary for the purposes of nominating candidates in an election.
