User Guideline

Supporter declarations

For Non-party Candidates



The *Electoral Act 1907* states that Legislative Council Candidates who are not endorsed by a registered political party must submit a minimum 250 declarations from electors in support of their nomination. Each supporter is required to complete <u>RO019A - Declaration in Support of a Nomination</u> and return it to the Candidate they are supporting.

This User Guideline has been provided to assist you - the Candidate - to instruct your supporters on completing and submitting the form, and your next steps once you have received the declarations.



Each of your supporters:

- Must be enrolled and entitled to vote in the state election.
- Cannot complete a form supporting another candidate in the state election.
- Must agree to being contacted by the WA Electoral Commission to verify eligibility.



Completing Form R0019A - Declaration in support of a Nomination, or equivalent.

- Form RO019A Declaration in Support of a Nomination is available on the Commission website <u>HERE</u>. The form can be downloaded and provided to supporters either electronically or in hard copy.
- Supporters can complete the form either electronically or in hard copy, and must ensure:
 - It includes your name (as the Candidate) and your contact details.
 - Their name provided in the 'Given names' and 'Surname' fields exactly matches their name as it appears on the electoral roll.
 - Their date of birth exactly matches their date of birth as it appears on the electoral roll.
 - All declarations must be signed by the supporter.
 - All information provided is accurate.
- You are permitted to provide an online version of the form for supporters to complete, however the fields must replicate those on the form.

NOTE: The above requirements must be met for the declaration to be accepted. Failure to produce a minimum of 250 unique acceptable declarations will result in the forfeit of your \$2000.00 deposit and your nomination will be deemed invalid.



Supporter signature

Supporters can sign the form by hand on a printed copy, or electronically by using a draw tool on screen or adding an image of their signature to the form.



Form collection

Every completed declaration form must be returned to you, the Candidate.

Digital forms can be emailed directly to you. Printed forms need to be scanned.



Declaration collation and submission

Each supporter declaration needs to be captured in RO019B Legislative Council Independent Candidate - Supporter details Spreadsheet.

Once you have collated the declarations and completed the spreadsheet, contact Legislative Council Returning Officer (LC RO) Louise Foppoli: sgro_lc@elections.wa.gov.au who will guide you through uploading your documents to a shared folder. **All documentation must be submitted electronically.**

The LC RO can be contacted for submission of declarations prior to the nomination open date. **Nominations open Thursday 6 February 2025.**
