

# How to vote in a State election

English

Voting is your opportunity to have a say about who represents you in government.

Your vote is your choice. You choose who to vote for.

Your vote is secret. No-one else should see who you vote for.

## How to vote in a State election

- You can ask for help at any time.
- You can ask for new ballot papers if you make a mistake.
- Ask an election worker if you need an interpreter.

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At the polling place you will be asked 3 questions:


- Have you already voted in this election?
- What is your full name?
- What is the address of where you live?



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
You will be given 2 ballot papers:

- **Small ballot** – for the Legislative Assembly (lower house of Parliament)
- **Large ballot** – for the Legislative Council (upper house of Parliament)



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Take your ballots to the cardboard voting area

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
## Fill in your ballots:

### Small ballot (Legislative Assembly)

Write numbers in every square in the order of your choice.

For example, write 1 for your first choice, 2 for your second choice and continue until all the squares are numbered.

- Don't leave any blank squares.
- Don't use ticks or crosses. Only use numbers.
- Don't repeat numbers.



### Large ballot (Legislative Council)

You can choose whether you want to vote 'above' or 'below' the thick line on the ballot paper. You can't do both.

Mark the ballot paper:

#### Above the line:

number one or more squares.

#### Below the line:


number 20 or more squares in the order of your choice. You don't have to number all the squares if you don't want to.

<p><b>If you vote BELOW the-line:</b></p> <p>Write the numbers 1 to 20 in the squares to the left of the names of the candidates of your choice. You can make more choices if you want to, by writing more numbers in the other squares in order, starting from number 21. You don't need to write a number in every square.
