Electoral Commissioner's introduction

2013–2014 Political Finance ANNUAL REPORT

Section 175ZG(1) of the *Electoral Act 1907* (the Act) requires the Electoral Commissioner to prepare and submit an annual report to the Minister regarding the operation of Part VI of the Act in relation to the financial year.

There were no electoral events held in the 2013–2014 reporting period. Nevertheless, the Western Australian Electoral Commission (the Commission) has continued to undertake post-election activity in addition to the annual requirements of Part VI of the Act.

The Commission has met with a number of political parties following the review undertaken at the beginning of the reporting period, which audited compliance by political parties. Feedback was provided to the political parties concerning the issues highlighted by the review. These issues were discussed in the previous political finance report for 2012–2013. The Commission continues to pursue an educative approach to non-compliance.

The Commission submitted four recommendations in the 2012–2013 political finance report for consideration, in response to the non-compliance issues raised by the review and with the aim of achieving greater transparency. The recommendations contained in the report for 2012–2013 continue to be supported by the Commission. The recommendation proposed in this 2013–2014 report is in response to a review undertaken by the Public Sector Commission.

Overall, annual disclosures submitted for the 2013–2014 period, by political parties and their associated entities, met lodgement obligations specified in the Act.

In preparation for the next reporting period, as well as for the 2017 State General Election, the Commission will continue its liaison with political parties and associated entities where necessary to address the non-compliance issues revealed by the most recent review.

The first section of this political finance report provides a summary of disclosures and public funding for the 2013–2014 financial year. The second section presents one recommendation for consideration to improve the operation of Part VI of the Act. 1. Financial disclosures

1.1 Annual returns by political parties and associated entities

- \$18,376,131.36 in gifts and other income was declared by 11 political parties.
- \$1,388,650.00 in gifts and other income was declared by five associated entities.

Political parties and associated entities are entitled to meet their State disclosure obligations by lodging the same return prepared for the Australian Electoral Commission under the *Commonwealth Electoral Act 1918*¹, if they are obliged to submit a Federal return. Four registered political parties met their disclosure requirements by submitting their Federal return for the 2013–2014 reporting period.

Recommendation

2013–2014 Political Finance ANNUAL REPORT

The Commission has proposed several recommendations in the Political Finance Annual Reports to Parliament since the 2013 State General Election, and remains keen to have those issues considered and addressed prior to the 2017 State General Election. Those recommendations are not repeated in this report, however, they can be found in the previous reports available online at www.elections.wa.gov.au.

The following recommendation is made in consideration of a review undertaken by the Public Sector Commission² concerning compliance obligations for public agencies.

Streamline the classes of expenditure which public agencies must disclose, under section 175ZE of the Act, to combine advertising agencies and media advertising organisations into the one class of expenditure.

Rationale

Work by advertising agencies and media advertising organisations is becoming increasingly integrated, with a number of public sector agencies capturing costs under one class of expenditure or the other, without the capacity to readily disaggregate spending between the two categories for disclosure purposes³. The main query from public agencies is about how to differentiate between the two classes of expenditure. The matter is complicated by the absence of definitions that would otherwise allow those agencies to make clear delineation about their spending in these areas. Combining the two classes of expenditure will remove the confusion that exists currently in disclosing and reporting on these figures.


