ELECTORAL ENROLMENT STATISTICS

31 March 2011

This report details State electoral enrolment figures as at 31 March 2011 and shows that on that date the total State enrolment was 1,372,700.

This report includes figures that illustrate the percentage change in total enrolment for each electoral district since 26 February 2007. Enrolment figures taken at that date were used to calculate the quotas on which the last redistribution of State boundaries was based.
